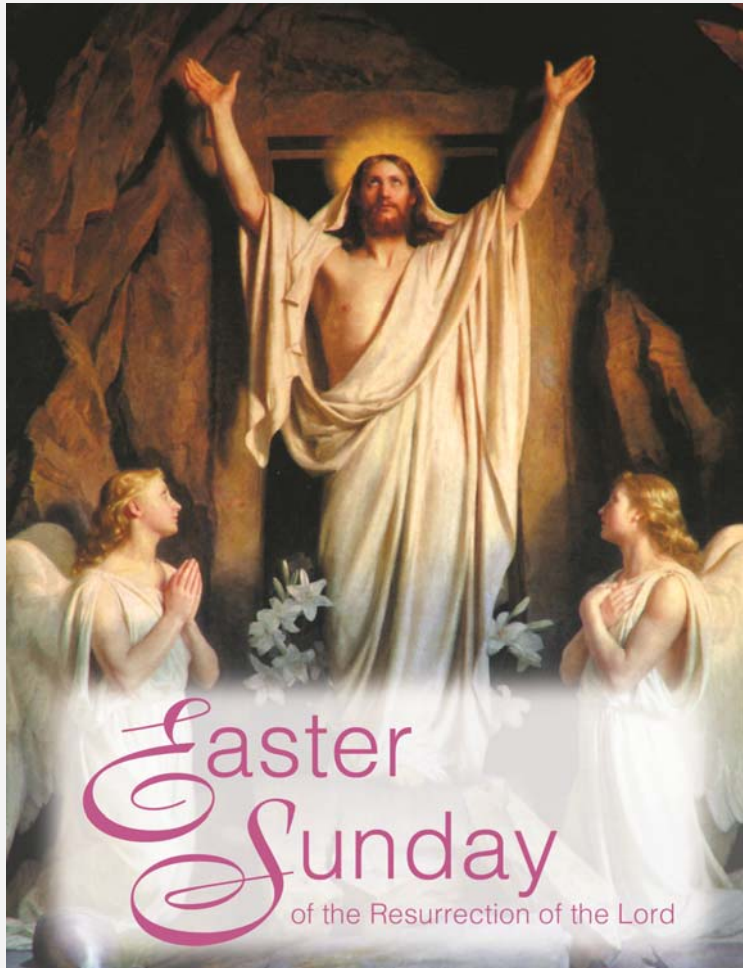

You can return your form to CCD or by placing it in an envelope marked CCD and dropping it in the collection basket. (Special request deadline May!) **If you are an active member of St. Joan of Arc parish, the materials fee is \$45.00 for the one child or \$75.00 for two or more children. If you are an in-active member or outside the parish, the fee is \$60.00 for one child or \$90.00 for two or more children.** (You are considered an active member if you come to Mass regularly and contribute to the church via the envelope system. **Kindergarten is optional.** Class size is limited, so sign up early...first come first served. **Register NOW These prices are for early registration only!**

**Help Needed!** The Religious Education Program is in need of teachers. You need not have a child in the program, (but, parents, this truly could be quality time spent with your child) but, **you must have a love of God and children.** *You would have to be here each week for class.
